The Graduate Studies Center in Management (NPGA), in the exercise of its duties, hereby publishes the Internal Selection Notice for Visiting Professor Candidates.

We are looking for candidates who can expand and deepen our strengths in one or more of the following research areas:

- Public Administration and Society;
- Education, Learning, and Management;
- Organizational Studies; and
- Technology, Competitiveness and Markets.

REQUIREMENTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The successful candidate(s) is/are expected to teach graduate courses; co-supervise graduate research projects; collaborate on ongoing research projects at NPGA; publish jointly with one or more permanent faculty members of NPGA; and contribute to the development of international research networks and projects involving NPGA faculty.

If the candidate receives final approval from UFBA, they will be required to undertake **full-time, in-person activities for a minimum period of one year**, renewable for up to one more year for Brazilian candidates and up to three more years for foreign candidates. Activities are scheduled to begin in August 2026, but this date is negotiable.

Priority will be given to senior visiting professors with a high scientific output, professional and mentoring experience, aiming to make an effective contribution to the Program's scientific production, human resource development, and cooperation network, both within and outside UFBA, facilitating joint proposals that may result in scientific and academic outcomes. Candidates must meet the prerequisites for accreditation as a NPGA permanent professor, available in the Policy for Accreditation, Reaccreditation, and De-accreditation of Professors – Researchers (PPGA Academic), which can be accessed at the link below: <https://npga.ufba.br/npga/governanca/#normas>

This selection process is part of a general call for applications from the **Federal University of Bahia**. We emphasize the importance of all candidates reading the call for applications to ensure they fully meet the requirements described therein. Candidates should carefully review the documents, criteria, requirements, and deadlines outlined in the general call for applications. The NPGA is responsible for nominating (pre-selecting) candidates, who will then be selected by a university committee designated for this task. - a) Application form (attached);
- b) Curriculum Vitae, in PDF format, including information from the Lattes Platform (CV Lattes only for Brazilians);
- c) Ph.D. diploma, in PDF format;
- d) Work plan (maximum 10 pages), detailing the academic and scientific activities to be carried out within the Graduate Program during the contract period — such as teaching, supervision, research, and technical and bibliographic production —, specifying the planned schedule and the expected products/results. The work plan must be signed and initialed by the candidate in PDF format.
